



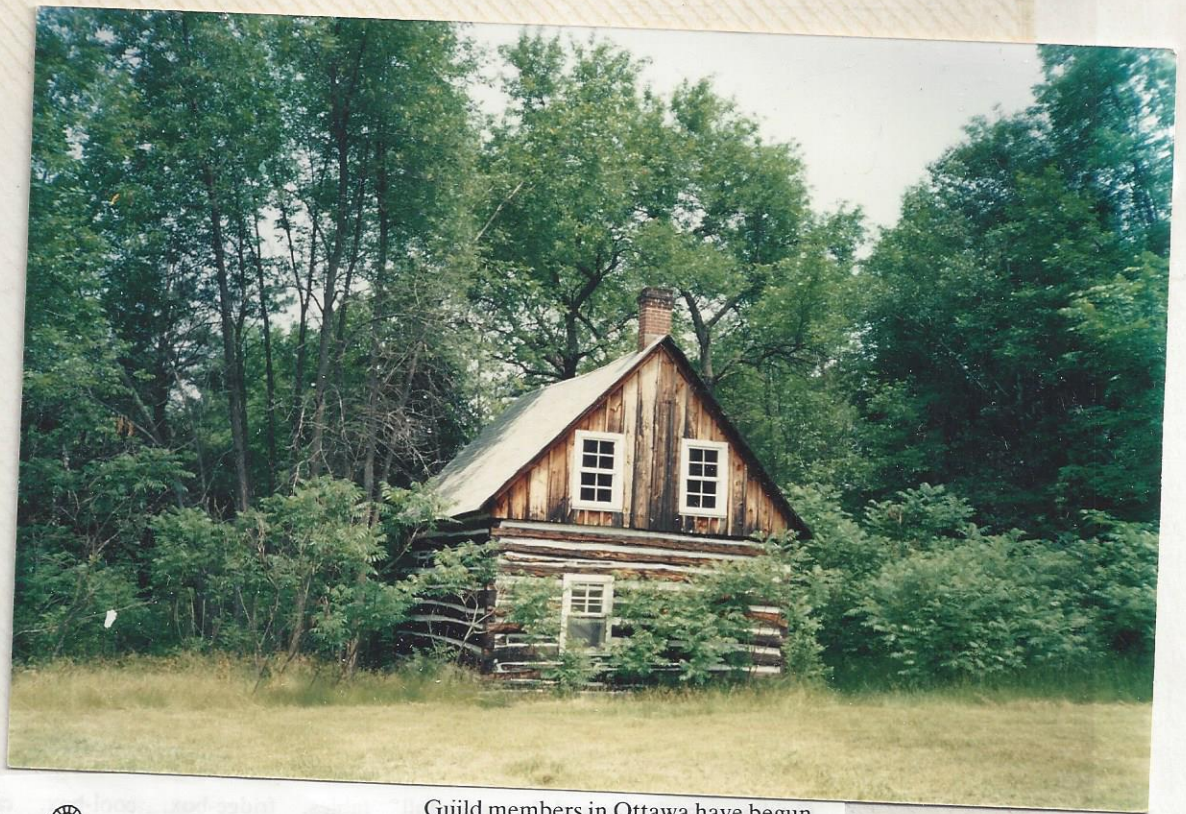
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Renovation of Pinhey Cottage

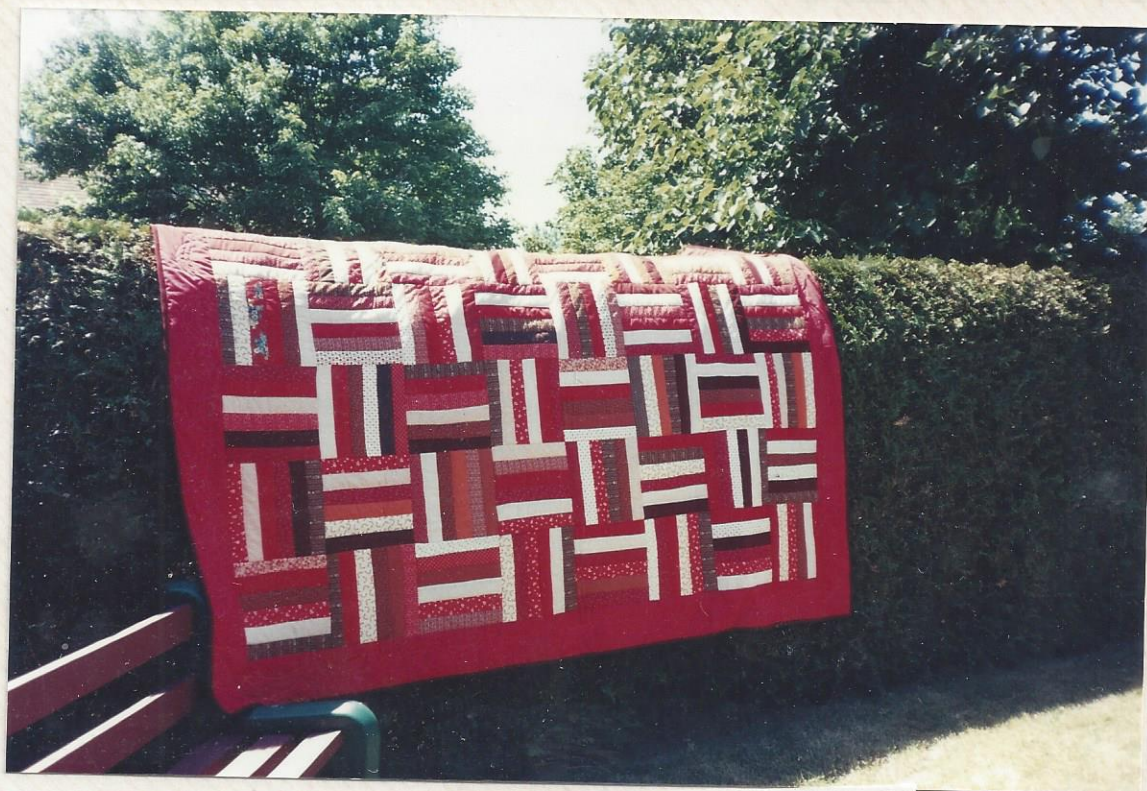

DONATIONS TO PINHEY COTTAGE - 1991

<u>Eleanor Tack</u>	Dishes and household items.
<u>Orville O'Brien</u>	(B.P. National President) A Pioneer planer's axe, a survey map of 19th century Torbolton County where Pinhey Cottage is located (map names and all the land owners including the Griersons), and a dried wildflower arrangement in a pioneer black kettle plus a container of wildflower seeds.
<u>Carol Walsh</u>	Braided rug and cushion.
<u>Ida Dale</u>	Autumn-patterned cushions, large oval braided rug in brown tones.
<u>Rachel Rose</u>	Cushions, garden plants, plus many hours of work.
<u>Pat Carllson</u>	Dining table. (Pat is a Gloucester Guider)
<u>Kit Irving</u>	Pioneer rocker for upstairs, curtain rods, 2 litres of paint, plus many hours of work.
<u>Grace Lefebvre</u>	Lamp, oil painting of Pinhey Cottage, material for curtains and covers (sewn by Kit Irving), vacuum, chest, quilted wallhanging, quilts for two beds, cushions, etc., and many hours of work.
<u>Art Wolff</u>	Donated his labour to install four lights downstairs, returned unused lumber to D. Kemp Edwards, removed garbage to the dump from Pinhey Cottage and repaired some of the shingles on the roof of Pinhey Cottage.
<u>Gwen Atkinson</u>	(Guide Store Manager) Donated \$80.00 which purchased five light fixtures.
<u>Karen Benedict</u>	Donated \$16.00 for the sixth light fixture, new light bulbs, two large braided rugs (one red oval and one green round), plus some small scatter rugs and many hours of work.
<u>Bob Gibbs</u>	Supplied approximately \$35.00 worth of finish trim and varnish, used lumber etc., as well as donating his expertise and countless hours of work to finish the upstairs in Pinhey Cottage, the screen door handle and hinges were also supplied by Bob.
<u>John Lefebvre</u>	Made and donated the cupboard for the dishes, made a log birdhouse, repaired the door and donated the door handle, donated approximately \$65.00 worth of mouldings, etc., including many hours of work, and an oil lamp, handmade the frame for the picture of H.M. the Queen, supplied paint brushes and a paint cleaner.
<u>Margaret Barker</u>	Donated her time to painting the door frame and the downstairs floor.
<u>Trefoil Guild</u>	Purchased a goose doorstep for Pinhey Cottage at the Guild's building fund bazaar. (handicraft made by two of our members, Lorna Miles and Bernice Brown) <i>money donated by Barrhaven Church Bazaar</i>
